MAGNETIC PAINT

Article designation: Magnetic paint is a liquid, rustproof internal wall paint which is water-based and easy to work with. Only two coatings will create a magnetic wall to which you can attach various objects with the aid of magnets.

Description of material: The water-based, highly flexible magnetic paint lets you economically and easily apply any magnetic coating you need. It is ideal for creating presentation surfaces on walls in offices, conference rooms, schools, children's rooms, shops and nursery schools.

Processing: The magnetic paint is generously applied to the desired surface with a brush, foam roller or short-fibre roller. Subsurfaces must be dry, firm and overpaintable. Suitable surfaces are internal facades such as: Plaster, masonry, wallpaper, textiles, concrete, plasterboard and ceiling boards.

Consumption: 200 g/m² - 300 g/m² per coating

You need 1 kg of magnetic paint (equivalent to approx. 500 ml) for two coats to obtain a magnetic wall of approx. 2m² - 3m²

Colour: Blue (greyish)

Label: No hazardous substance in terms of the German Ordinance on Hazardous Substances. Statutory regulations are subject to frequent changes. The current safety data sheet should therefore be consulted for particulars about marking and environmental protection.

Delivery: In 1 kg and 2 kg containers
