Product Description :	Smoke Pellets – PH003 and PH005
NAME OF PRODUCT:	Smoke Emitter Pellets
DESCRIPTION:	Smoke Pellets for testing flues, chimneys, ventilation systems, fire training etc.
POTENTIAL HARARDS:	Inhalation irritation, possible nausea / runny eyes after prolonged and concentrated exposure
WASTE DISPOSAL:	With normal household refuse, inside manufacturers packaging
ADVICE ON LABEL:	Warning – Irritant, Not edible, Keep away from children, chest sufferers wear a mask, not for sale to minors, dispose of spent pellet safely

CHEMICAL COMPOSITION

AMMONIUM CHLORIDE:	Ammonium perchlorate, chlorinated rubber, combusting to give primarily ammonium chloride, carbon dioxide and water

OPERATIONAL EXPOSURE LIMITS

AMMONIUM CHLORIDE:	20mgs per m ³ in a 10 minute period. A pellet burns for 60 seconds.
OTHER CHEMICALS:	Values for all other chemicals in the smoke are well below M.E.L.s in an average room of circa 21m ³

FIRST AID

INHALATION:	Vacate work area, and breathe in fresh air until irritation ceases
SKIN CONTACT:	Wash area with soapy water
EYE CONTACT:	Irrigate eyes with fresh running water
INGESTION:	If less than one pellet, dilute with water, if more than one pellet seek medical advice
FLASH POINT:	None
SYNERGISTIC REACTIONS:	None
PROTECTIVE CLOTHING:	Continual heavy uses should wear a mask
